Jan Dash is the UU-UN Office's Climate Initiative Chair and Managing Editor of their Climate Portal. He was the Editor of the Climate Statement Summary and Recommendations to Governments of the UN-NGO Committee on Sustainable Development, delivered to leaders at Copenhagen and other Climate Conferences. He is a Matchmaker for the Climate Science Rapid Response Team providing authoritative scientific responses to media questions. He is the author of the popular "one-liner" responses to climate contrarian/denier/faux-skeptic fallacies. Jan has a PhD in physics and has published over 50 papers in scientific journals. He is Adjunct Professor at the Courant Institute NYU. Relevant to the economic impacts of global warming, Jan has worked for many years in quantitative finance and risk management, and wrote a book on the subject.
