Participants will learn how to assist undocumented youth who may qualify, and help them navigate the complex federal process for achieving or renewing their deferred status through the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.

The training program will provide a wide array of practical information on DACA, screening tools, application instructions and other useful materials to assist DREAMers who want to apply for relief under DACA. Participants will learn the essential elements of setting up a DACA clinic and how CASA successfully involves attorneys as backup to volunteers at their clinics.
